All competitors must make weight prior to their first fight for both Gi and No Gi Divisions.

All entries together with waivers must be received by the AFBJJ no later than Monday the 12th of October.

There is no qualification necessary to compete. All competitors must belong to an AFBJJ Affiliate academy. All Affiliate academies must be paid up to the 30/6/10. Competitors will be refused entry where their Affiliate academy membership remains unpaid.
